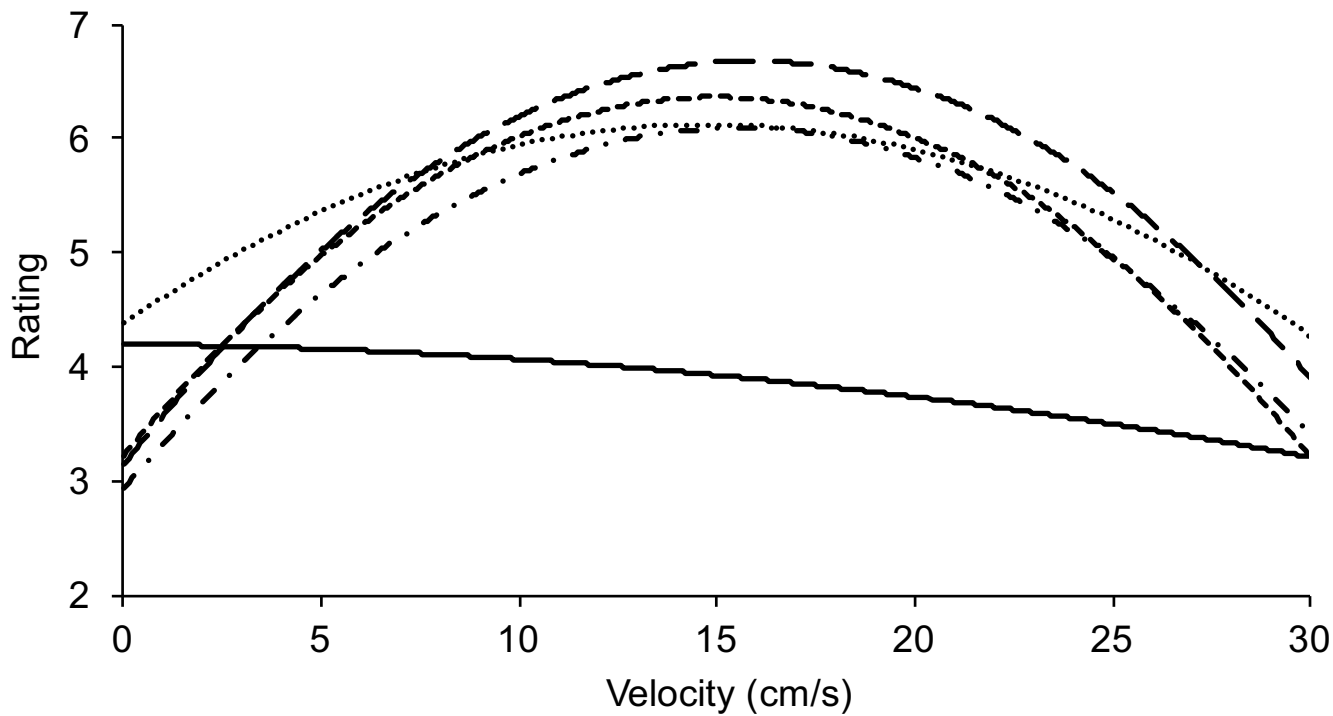

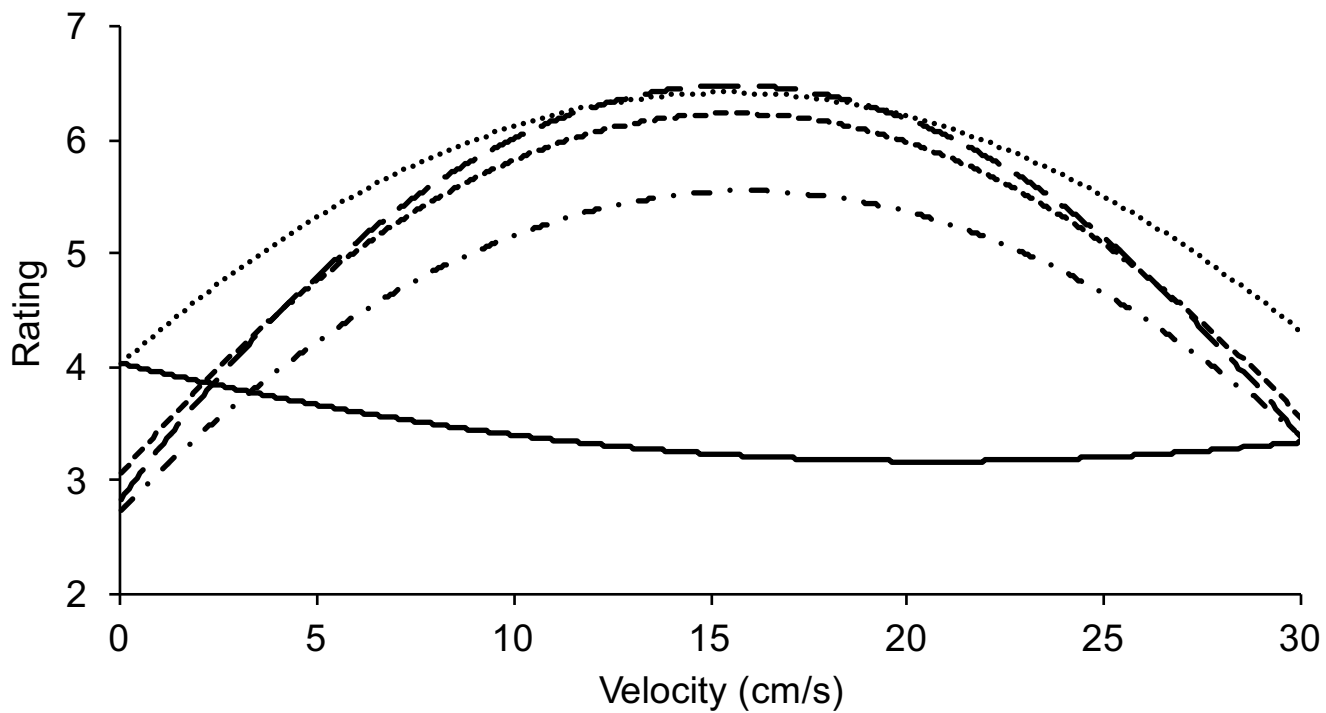
Q1. How pleasant do you think that action was for the person being touched?
